Scheduled Systems Update Announcement

September 12, 2016

The Clerk's Office will be performing a systems upgrade which will impact the ExParte Via the Clerk (EPVC) and the Electronic Working Copies systems. **The upgrade is expected to be available September 12, 2016.** Below is an outline of some of the system enhancements.

EPVC System Enhancements

- <u>EPVC Confirmation Receipts:</u> EPVC users now have the option of "saving" their confirmation receipts to their local computer drive.
- <u>Agreed/Stipulated Orders:</u> Users will now be able to submit agreed or stipulated orders for Ex Parte review in either Word format (.doc or .docx) or in PDF format, with signatures scanned.
- Returns via Email: The "return via" feature now includes a field for customers to enter their email address so that documents being returned (regular, conformed, certified copies, or other documents) may be returned electronically.
- <u>Fee Waiver Option:</u> Users will now be able to submit orders with eligible fee waivers (i.e. guardianships with assets less than \$3,000) using the "Fee Waiver" button.

Change to Electronic Working Copies:

With this release, proposed orders being submitted with electronic working copies in the eFiling Application, must be in Word format (.doc or .docx). <u>Proposed orders in Word Perfect format are no longer supported.</u>
