Chief Civil – Judge Julie Spector
Chief Juvenile – Judge Judith Ramseyer
Chief Criminal – Judge Sean O'Donnell (continues in this role)
Asst. Chief Criminal – Judge Veronica Alicea-Galvan

Other changes of note: The Drug Court calendars will be heard by Judge Dean Lum in Seattle (continues in this role) and Judge Julia Garratt in Kent. Judge Mary Roberts will hear the Involuntary Treatment Act (ITA) calendar. Judges Elizabeth Berns will be the Lead Dependency Judge and Judges Theresa Doyle (SEA) and Mafe Rajul (KNT) will hear the Dependency calendars. Chief Civil Judge Julie Spector will be on the Seattle Ex Parte calendar.

Many other judges are changing assignment, court location and/or courtroom. Those moves happen effective January 7, 2019.
