Notice Regarding a New Family Law Notice of Court Date

Effective immediately, a new form called the "*Notice of Court Date- Family Law Commissioners Non-Capped*" should be used to set ONLY the following types of motions in front of the Family Law Commissioners:

- Motions on the Trial By Affidavit Calendar (these are heard without oral argument)
- Motions for Reconsideration of an order signed by a family law Commissioner (also heard without oral argument)
- Motions set by the Family Support Prosecutor, or by the Defense representing respondents, for state-filed Parentage, adjustments and child support contempt proceedings.

The new Notice of Court Date for uncapped motions *must not be used for other types of family law motions, ONLY for those listed above.* All other types of family law motions are capped, and are set using the Notice of Court Date-Family Law form. Using the incorrect Notice form may result in your hearing not being set on the docket and not being heard.
