Notice Regarding the Suspension of In-Person Civil Jury Trials Until April 26, 2021

Emergency Order 31 extends the suspension of in-person jury trials for civil cases through April 26, 2021. If public health indicators with regard to the pandemic continue to improve, in-person jury trials for civil cases will resume at the Meydenbauer Center April 26, 2021 through July 30, 2021, subject to biweekly review.

At this time, the Meydenbauer Center is no longer available for Superior Court use on August 2, 2021. Thereafter, the Court expects civil bench and civil jury trials to be held remotely, until social distancing no longer requires multiple courtrooms to conduct a jury trial in the King County Courthouse and Maleng Regional Justice Center.
