**EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING
PARTIAL EXTENSION OF # 29
RE: JUVENILE OFFENDER
OPERATIONS**


This matter comes before the Court on the public health emergency in Washington State.

1. Paragraph 1 of Emergency Order 29, regarding procedures governing juvenile offender operations during the public health emergency filed on January 22, 2021 ("Order"), states that the Juvenile Court is authorized to take all necessary steps to ensure all matters and hearing types proceed with as few persons physically present in the courtroom as possible. That Paragraph alone is **EXTENDED** through the close of business on July 30, 2021.

2. This Court shall review all relevant public health information again no later than **July 16, 2021**, to determine if the health risks presented by coronavirus pandemic continue and require a further extension of this Order.
