III. ORDER ISSUING SUMMONS (ORISM)

2.2 Pursuant to RCW 13.32A.250(6) the Court:

FINDS probable cause to believe that a placement order was violated.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Good cause having being shown, it is hereby ordered that the Clerk of this Court issue a **Summons** for the youth. The youth must appear at the time, date and location identified above. Failure to appear may result in the Court directing law enforcement to pick up and take the child to detention.

OR

IV. ORDER ISSUING WARRANT (ORW)

2.3 Pursuant to RCW 13.32A.250(6) the Court:

FINDS probable cause to believe that a placement order was violated.

The Court finds probable cause to believe that the child would not appear in response to the Command/summons or finds probable cause to believe that the arrest is necessary to prevent serious harm to the juvenile or another.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Good cause having being shown, it is hereby ordered that the Clerk of this Court issue a warrant for the apprehension of the respondent.

Tier 1 Warrant - Bail in this warrant shall **NOT BE ALLOWED**; the arrestee shall be detained pending a court hearing.

Tier 2 Warrant (PR) - Respondent shall be released from custody after signing for Personal Recognizance and a return date, assuming parent(s)/guardian(s) will accept child back in the home.

INFORMATION FOR PARTIES:

3.1 If an arrest warrant is issued:

Pursuant to RCW 13.32A.250(6) and 13.32A.065(1), FOLLOWING A CHILD'S ADMISSION TO DETENTION, a **DETENTION REVIEW HEARING must be HELD WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS**, (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays). Detention screening shall so notify parties and attorneys of record.

3.2 If an arrest warrant is not issued, and the matter is scheduled for a contempt hearing:

a. **It is the petitioner's responsibility to have the above-named person served by someone other than the petitioner, who is over the age of eighteen, and to provide proof of such service at the hearing.**

b. **The petitioner must serve all attorneys of record.**

3.3 Pursuant to RCW 13.32A.250 (6), IF THE COURT MAKES A FINDING OF CONTEMPT, the Court MAY IMPOSE A FINE of up to one hundred dollars and CONFINEMENT for up to seven days, or both.

3.4 **To Quash A Warrant:**

The Warrant Quash Calendar begins at 1:00 p.m. Monday – Friday. Youth must sign up no later than 2:00 p.m. the day before they want to appear in court. You may sign up for a day further out than one day, i.e., sign up today for next week. Anyone may sign up a youth for the Quash Calendar: the youth, the parent, the attorney, a community support person. When arriving for your Quash Hearing **first sign in at the front desk in the lobby of Family Court Services at the King County Courthouse (516 Third AVE, Room W-280, Seattle, WA, 98104). You may then proceed to courtroom W-275 for your hearing.** Your name will be called when it is time for your court hearing.
