INSTRUCTIONS FOR CALLING INTO YOUR HEARING ARE BELOW:

ON THE DATE OF YOUR HEARING

- 1. You can attend either by video or by phone. Video is preferred.**
 - a. To Join by Video:** Click on the zoom link to join by video. If you have trouble clicking cut and paste the link into your browser. You may be asked to enter the meeting number. The meeting number is the same regardless of whether you join by video or phone. **Please label yourself by your name and your role (Petitioner, Respondent, Witness, Attorney for Petitioner, Observer, etc.).**
 - b. To Join by Phone: Call the number posted on our website** at your scheduled hearing time. When prompted enter the meeting number. The meeting number is the same regardless of whether you join by video or phone.
- 2. When you join the meeting,** please refrain from speaking until asked to speak by the judge or bailiff. The bailiff will check you in.
- 3. ALL SCHEDULED CASE PARTIES MAY BE ON THE LINE (NOT JUST THE PARTIES FOR YOUR MATTER).** As this is an open court not only the judge and parties relevant to your case will be on the line. Parties from other cases on the calendar, witnesses, and the general public may also call in.
- 4. After check-in, wait until your case is called.**
 - a. Telephone Appearance:** If you are appearing via telephone you may want to use a speakerphone while you wait. Please use this function only if you have a mute function as every sound picked up by your speakerphone will be heard by everyone in the courtroom.
 - b. Video appearance:** Please use the mute function if you are not speaking.
- 5.** When called, identify yourself each time you speak and conduct yourself as you would if you were in the Courtroom. Remember this is an open virtual courtroom.
- 6. If the Court does not join the call within 15 minutes** after your scheduled hearing time, please email **the assigned court**. Do not leave the conference line or place the conference line on hold. If you cannot email the court, hang up and call 206-477-1400 for assistance.

7. **REMEMBER once Court has commenced, DO NOT INTERRUPT.** You will have an opportunity to speak. If the call is in progress and you hear voices, wait until an opportunity to speak arises without interrupting others. The Bailiff may be performing a check-in and will get to you.

DO NOT RECORD ANY COURT HEARINGS

The Court keeps a record of all proceedings. Do not record any court proceedings. You can order copies of the hearing from the Court. If you would like to order a copy of the record of the proceeding, information can be found on the CourtClerk's Web:
