Party requesting criminal motion must file any written motion & affidavits separately along with this notice. Serve a copy of this notice, with motion documents, on all parties.

Motion documents must be filed with the Clerk’s Office and served on all parties. Motions will be set no sooner than 6 court days from the date the motion is filed or within 6 days of the trial date absent an order shortening time. Orders shortening time should be presented to the criminal motions judge. The moving party shall comply with LCR 7(b)(10).
