The DNA sample SHALL be obtained before the Defendant is released from custody by this order. However, the Defendant SHALL NOT serve any additional days in custody solely for the purpose of obtaining the sample unless the Defendant refuses to provide the sample. If the Defendant refuses to provide a sample as ordered, he or she shall remain in custody, DAJD shall notify the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, and a hearing will be set on the next available violation (SRA) calendar to address the refusal. If the Defendant later chooses to provide a sample as ordered, he or she shall be released no later than the following business day, after the sample is obtained pursuant to this order.
