**FINDINGS AND ORDER OF RELIEF  
RE 5TH AMENDMENT**

**5<sup>th</sup> Amendment finding and relief:**

The Court finds the defendant has a 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment privilege not to submit a Proof of Surrender or Declaration of Non-Surrender because a real and substantial danger exists such declarations might result in injurious disclosure that could provide a link in the chain of evidence in this or a subsequent prosecution. The defendant is disqualified from possession of firearms or dangerous weapons by prior conviction, existing protection order, other legal process, and/or the defendant is being investigated for or charged with an incident involving possession or use of a firearm or dangerous weapon. The Court relieves the defendant on constitutional grounds of the statutory requirement to submit a declaration regarding the possession or surrender of firearms.
