# How to Withdraw Funds from a Blocked Account – Minor Turns 18 years old

This instruction explains how to ask the court to release funds from a blocked account once the minor turns 18 years old.

# Talk to a lawyer if you can

These instructions have been developed by the King County Superior Court Family Law Information Center. They are not intended to be a substitute for legal advice. They provide only legal *information*. It's a good idea to talk to a lawyer before you file any forms. If you cannot afford a lawyer, you can:

- Find a lawyer to help you with the *most difficult* parts of your case, such as reviewing your forms, explaining how to get ready for court and confirming this is the best legal action for your case. You can contact the King County Bar Association to ask for a referral.
- Ask the Family Law Facilitator's office for a list of low-cost and free legal resources.

## Step 2: Getting your order approved

Walk in to the Clerk's office.

Bring the completed petition, order, and valid photo ID of the former minor. The Clerk will stamp your documents with a "present in person" stamp and send you to the Ex Parte courtroom (1J in Kent and W325 in Seattle) where the Commissioner will review and sign your order.

You will need a certified copy of the signed order to take to the bank so that the funds can be released.

Review the signed *Order on Request for Withdrawal from Blocked Account/Terminate Guardianship* carefully to see if the Commissioner requires you to file the *Receipt of Funds from Blocked Financial Account* once the funds are transferred to you.
