The Respondent agrees to give up this right and agrees that the new commencement date and the new expiration date are as specified in the caption of this order.

A Juvenile Drug Court Observation is scheduled as specified above. In Seattle, Juvenile Drug Court is held at the Youth Services Center, 1211 East Alder Street, Seattle, WA 98122, in either Courtroom 3 or Courtroom 7. In Kent, Juvenile Drug Court is held at the Maleng Regional Justice Center, 401 4th Avenue, North, Kent, WA 98032, in Courtroom 1L.
