**ORDER REVOKING STIPULATED ORDER OF  
CONTINUANCE AND FINDING RESPONDENT

- Failing to reside in housing approved by his/her parent or guardian or in placement authorized by Department of Social and Health Services or the court and/or to inform the JPC of a change of address or placement.
- Failing to attend at least 70% of drug/alcohol treatment counseling (Track III only)
- Failing to pay restitution
