

ADDENDUM FOR YOUTH WHO RECEIVE A CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY DISPOSITIONAL ALTERNATIVE (CDDA)

During the term of CDDA disposition, the offender will be subject to the CDDA community supervision case management standards. The following probation conditions also apply:

1. Maintain regular school attendance with no unexcused absences, tardies, or behavioral referrals, suspensions, and work to a level commensurate with ability.
2. Attend, actively participate and make satisfactory progress in treatment and counseling as directed by JPC. Counseling may include adolescent detoxification, inpatient, intensive outpatient, outpatient, and/or co-occurring treatment. The respondent shall not terminate counseling or change treatment providers without the prior permission of JPC. The respondent shall further comply with all components of any "treatment contract" developed by the JPC including any restrictions on travel, living conditions, and lifestyle requirements.
3. Submit to random urinalysis as directed by JPC.
4. Reside in a JPC approved residence and abide by all of the home rules.
5. Abide by a curfew as set by JPC and Parent/Guardian.
6. Not possess or use non-prescribed drugs or alcohol.
7. Not possess or use a weapon of any kind.
8. The respondent shall commit no new criminal law violations.

10. The respondent shall not leave the state of Washington without prior JPC permission.
