The King County Consortium proposes to amend its 2019 Annual Action Plan: One Year Use of Federal Funds, allocating \$5,663,680 in Community Development Block Grant Program Coronavirus (CDBG-CV3) funds and \$1,487,027 in CDBG-CV2 from Washington Department of Commerce. These funds may be used for rent assistance, emergency shelter, day shelters, food banks/food assistance, youth services, mental health services, senior services, other public service activities and assistance to small business and/or microenterprises and administration of programs to prevent, prepare for and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic.
