

Public Notice King County **Community Development Block Grant** (CDBG) Consortium

Notice of Fund Availability

King County estimates that \$750,000 in federal CDBG funds will be available in 2019 to King County and the cities and towns participating in the King County CDBG Consortium. CDBG funds are provided to King County annually by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

Activities eligible for funding include acquisition, construction and rehabilitation of nonprofit and public facilities, public improvements, housing rehabilitation, economic development and relocation. All CDBG funded activities must be consistent with the King County Consortium Housing and Community Development Plan for 2015-2019.

Required Pre-Applications will be available on February 28th via the Web and upon request.

These funds will be allocated by King County, cities and towns participating in the CDBG Consortium.
