Northeast Recycling and Transfer Station Community Criteria

- 1. Location has best travel times at most times of the day from within the service area.
- 2. Location is within 10 miles from any point in the service area and no closer than 5 miles to any other County recycling and transfer station.
- 3. Are there disproportionate impacts to historically and currently underserved and underrepresented communities? (includes immigrants, people of color, refugees and low-income populations).
- 4. Underserved and underrepresented community members and employees are able to conveniently access the site.
- 5. Site has fewest impacts to sensitive areas and avoids environmental red flags (e.g., landslide potential, wetlands, earthquake faults, aquifers that provide drinking water, etc.)
- 6. Site has fewest potential local community impacts (e.g., traffic, noise, odor).
- 7. Site best accommodates sustainable and innovative design.
- 8. Site has most reasonable cost.
- 9. Site acquisition has least impact on current or future residential or commercial use.
