- Think critically about how both individual actions and current systems impact habitats, ecosystems and wildlife



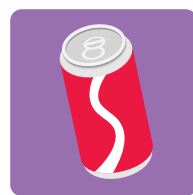
Plastic Pollution and Our Oceans (grades 6-9)
