Shoring installation ends this weekend

La instalación de secciones de acero apuntalar termina este fin de semana


Crews will continue installing temporary shoring through the weekend to minimize disruption to nearby businesses during normal weekday hours. Neighbors can expect noise and possible vibration through November 11. Crews will be working extended hours and Saturday and Sunday to complete this work by Monday morning. Thank you for your patience during this work.

This temporary shoring allows crews to safely connect the new siphon to the existing system in West Commodore Way (see map).

Crews will be working on Veteran's Day, Monday, November 12.

WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE SOUTH SITE THROUGH THE WEEKEND:

- Noise and possible vibration through the weekend
- Extended work hours and work on Saturday and Sunday
- High levels of activity involving equipment and trucks
- Increased truck traffic around West Commodore Way
