North and South Site Project Updates – December 20, 2013

NORTH SITE ACTIVITIES:

December 23 – 24 and 26 – 27: Crews will demolish concrete from the top of the north shaft with a concrete breaker. **This work will be noisy.**

Mid- January: Work begins to re-line the existing siphon. This work requires the north site construction area in Ballard to extend into Shilshole Avenue Northwest in front of the project site between 20th Avenue Northwest and Northwest Dock Place. A Detour will be in place for 4 months; **See reverse for more information.**



SOUTH SITE ACTIVITIES:

December 23 – 24 and 26 – 27: Crews will demolish concrete from the top of the south shaft with a concrete breaker. **This work will be noisy.**

December 30 – 31 and January 2: The last portion of shoring will be removed from the afterbay structure (see map). **Near neighbors may experience noise and vibration during shoring removal.**

Thank you for your patience during this work!

Week of January 6: Crews will begin work on the south site to reline the existing Ballard Siphon.

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Detour begins in mid-January 2014 on Shilshole Avenue Northwest

Desvío comienza a mediados de enero de 2014 en Shilshole Avenue Northwest

Beginning in mid-January, the existing Ballard Siphon will be relined once wastewater flow is transferred to the new siphon. The new pipe and existing siphon will accommodate growth in north Seattle and meet north Seattle's wastewater needs through the end of the century.

The relining work requires the construction area to extend into Shilshole Avenue Northwest in front of the project site between 20th Avenue Northwest and Northwest Dock Place (see map below).

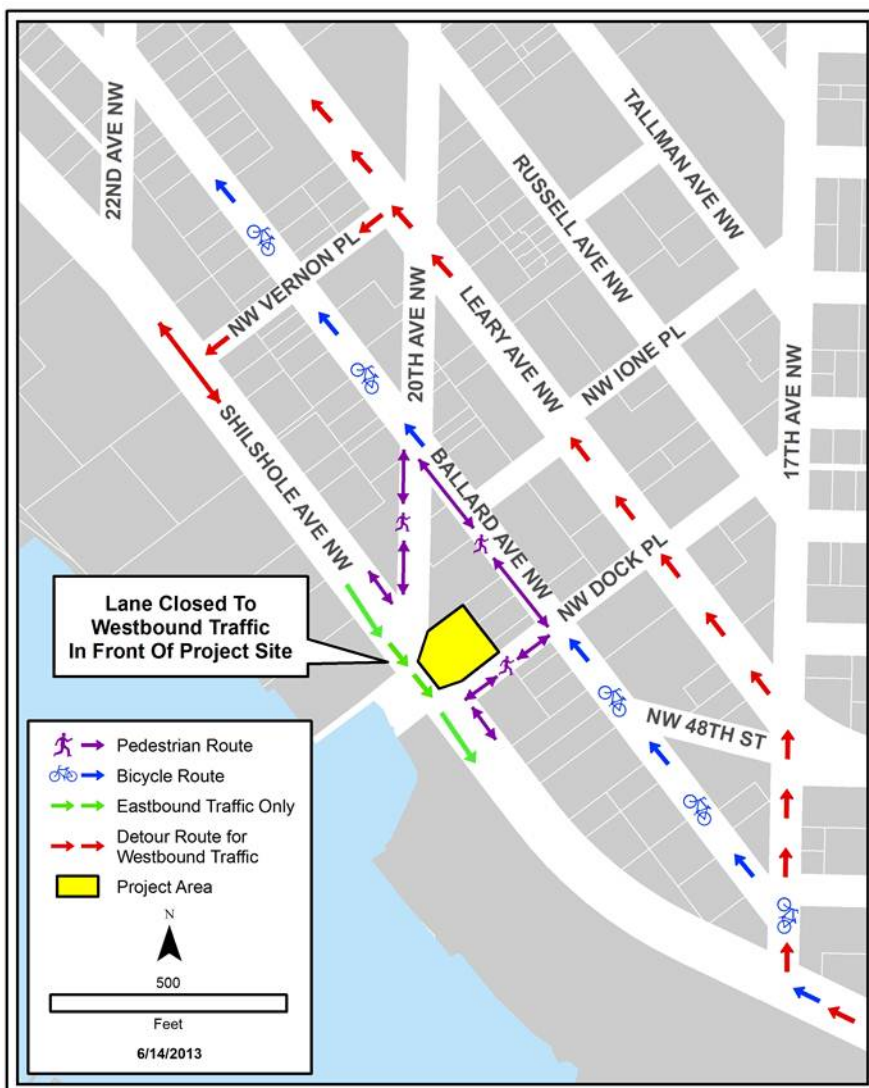
Traffic traveling west on Shilshole Avenue Northwest will be detoured to Leary Avenue West for approximately four months.

Westbound bicycles and pedestrians will be detoured to Ballard Avenue Northwest and should follow posted detour routes (see map).

Eastbound traffic will remain on Shilshole Avenue Northwest.

What to Expect During the Detour:

- Westbound traffic detoured to Leary Ave NW for four months
- Traffic control signs and flaggers to ease congestion
- Increased truck traffic along detour route
- May include parking restrictions along detour route
- Access to businesses on Shilshole Avenue Northwest will be maintained at all times



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
