

Shilshole Avenue Northwest traffic detour begins January 20

Desvío de tráfico en Shilshole Avenue Northwest comienza el 20 de enero

In January, wastewater flow will be transferred to the new siphon and the existing Ballard Siphon will be relined. The new pipe and existing siphon will accommodate growth in north Seattle and meet north Seattle’s wastewater needs through the end of the century.

The relining work requires the construction area to extend into Shilshole Avenue Northwest in front of the project site between 20th Avenue Northwest and Northwest Dock Place (see map below).

Beginning January 20, traffic traveling west on Shilshole Avenue Northwest will be detoured to Leary Avenue Northwest for approximately four months.

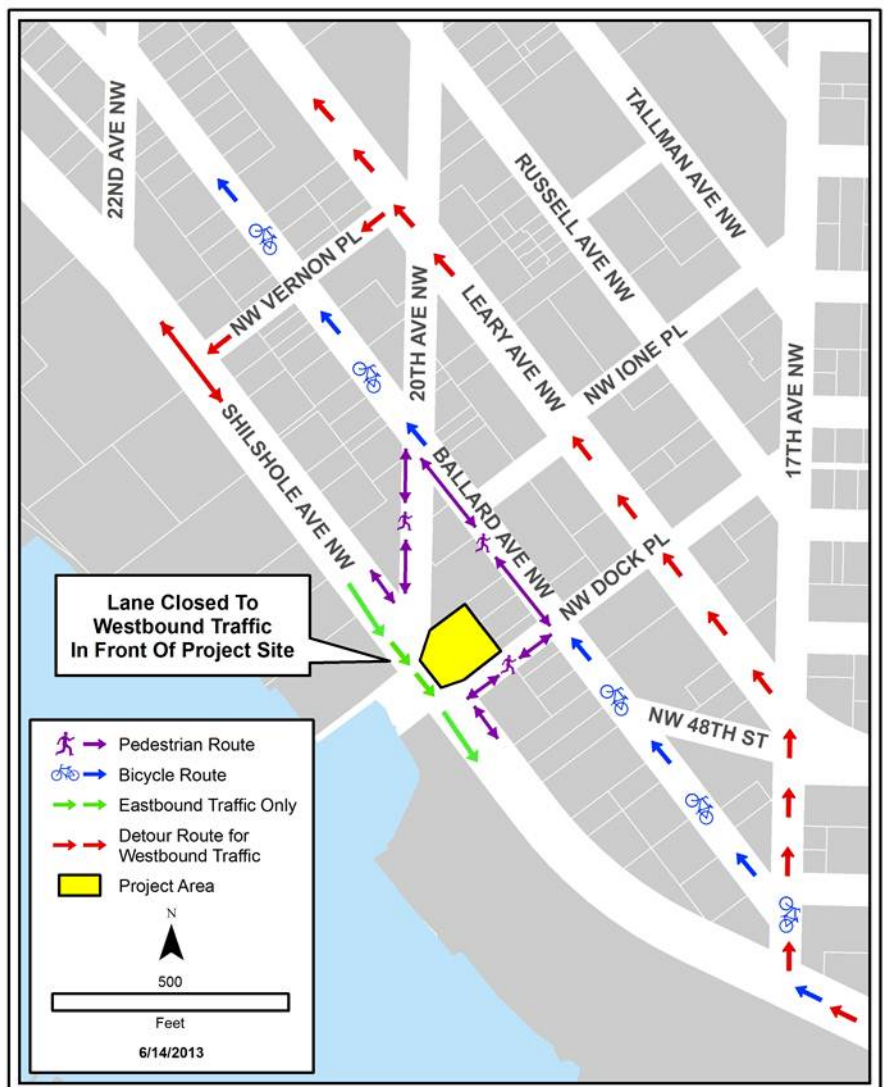
Westbound bicycles and pedestrians will be detoured to Ballard Avenue Northwest and should follow posted detour routes (see map).

Eastbound traffic will remain on Shilshole Avenue Northwest.

Please use caution when traveling through work areas, follow posted traffic signs, cones and flaggers and plan for extra travel time when commuting.

What to Expect During the Detour:

- Westbound traffic detoured to Leary Ave NW for four months
- Traffic control signs and flaggers to ease congestion
- Increased truck traffic along detour route
- May include parking restrictions along detour route
- Access to businesses on Shilshole Ave NW will be maintained at all times
