## Tree removal on designated blocks begins in early February



Streets where work will occur

Starting in early February, King County contractor crews will be in the Sunrise Heights and Westwood neighborhoods removing select trees to make room for the bioretention swales that will be constructed starting in March.

**33 trees will be removed across the project area. Trees to be removed are marked with yellow flyers.** These trees are small, unhealthy, or otherwise not suitable for transplant. Two trees will be replanted for every tree removed.

The crew will cut the trees into pieces and load them into a truck for recycling. Stumps will be removed below ground level with hand tools or stump grinding. The holes will be filled and sod will be placed over the stump location.

### What to expect:

- Work at each location to last approximately two hours
- Work in neighborhood to last up to two weeks
- Portion of sidewalk closed during tree removal
- Parking restrictions while crews are on street
- Work hours Monday-Friday 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Yellow flyers on trees slated for removal
