Background

King County Wastewater Treatment Division (WTD) has been working at and near Fairwood Elementary School for the last several years to improve the sewer system serving the Fairwood community. To complete the final stretch of work, King County will construct new pipes to connect portions of pipe laid earlier in the project.

Construction in the Playfield

As part of the final phase of work, a construction area in the Fairwood Elementary School playfield will remain active for the entire year. The construction area will be fenced at all times to keep your kids safe, and alternative areas and activities for recess play have been created.

Keeping Traffic Moving

Construction crews will also be digging up portions of Fairwood Boulevard this fall, which will create some traffic diversions and delays. Construction crews have been asked to time their work to avoid disrupting school buses and parents dropping off or picking up students. We appreciate your patience as we work out the kinks in this system.
