Praxair building demolition starts week of March 16, 2015

King County's contractor for the Fremont Siphon Replacement project will begin demolishing the Praxair building located in the Fremont (north) project area. Removing the building makes room for the project's north tunnel shaft. The microtunnel machine will be lowered 75 feet down the north shaft to bore holes under the Ship Canal for the new siphon's two 60-inch diameter pipes.

All of the work will occur inside the fenced area (see map). Demolishing the building requires use of excavators, trucks and frontend loaders.


Building materials will be recycled to the extent possible. Any remaining materials will be sent to a certified disposal site.

To protect public safety the sidewalk and parking lane on the north side of the building will be closed.

You can help keep the work area safe too. Avoid the project site during work hours, and do not engage individuals working at the site. Contact the 24-hour project information line (206-205-5428) with questions or concerns.

What to expect

- Work on weekdays from 7:00 a.m. 6 p.m.
- No access to the Praxair Building or parking area for the rest of the project
- Increased noise and activity at the site
- More trucks on roads near the site
- Closed sidewalks and no parking along the southern side of N.W. 36th St.



Sidewalks and parking along the south side of N.W. 36th St. will be closed while King County contractors remove the Praxair Building. Work starts the week of March 16, 2015.
