# Queen Anne Site Project Update - May 11, 2015

### Site preparation activities increase

King County's contractor will be working on the following tasks at the Queen Anne (south) project site in May:

- Fencing the project area
- Installing erosion control
- Establishing site entrances
- Providing temporary power to the site
- · Dewatering well drilling
- Set up of water treatment tanks

Some traffic detours will be required later this summer. King County will provide more information to project neighbors before detours occur.

#### What to expect during construction

- Work from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on weekdays, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturdays (as needed)
- Increased noise and activity at site
- More trucks on nearby roads

The following areas remain open:

- West Ewing Mini Park
- The dock near the King County Environmental Labs
- Nearby business delivery areas
