Project Update July 17, 2015

W. Ewing Alley and Ship Canal Trail close the week of July 20 as pipe installation begins

King County's contractor for the Fremont Siphon will begin installing a 9-foot diameter pipe to connect the new siphon and the existing sewer system on July 20. W. Ewing Alley and the Ship Canal Trail will be closed between 6th Ave NW and 3rd Ave NW in Queen Anne while this work occurs (see map). Vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians will be detoured to nearby streets through August.

DETOURS:
