Fremont Site Project Update

October 3, 2016

### Night work at Fremont site on October 5 - expect crews and lights onsite

King County's contractor plans to work continuously on the Fremont project site overnight Wednesday, October 5 into the morning of Thursday, October 6.

Crews will be returning sewage flows from a temporary bypass pipe to the newly installed pipes connected to the existing sewer system. The work will begin during normal work hours, but must be completed at night when the pipes are not as full.

There will be crews onsite and additional lighting. Noise levels will be similar to typical construction activity noise.

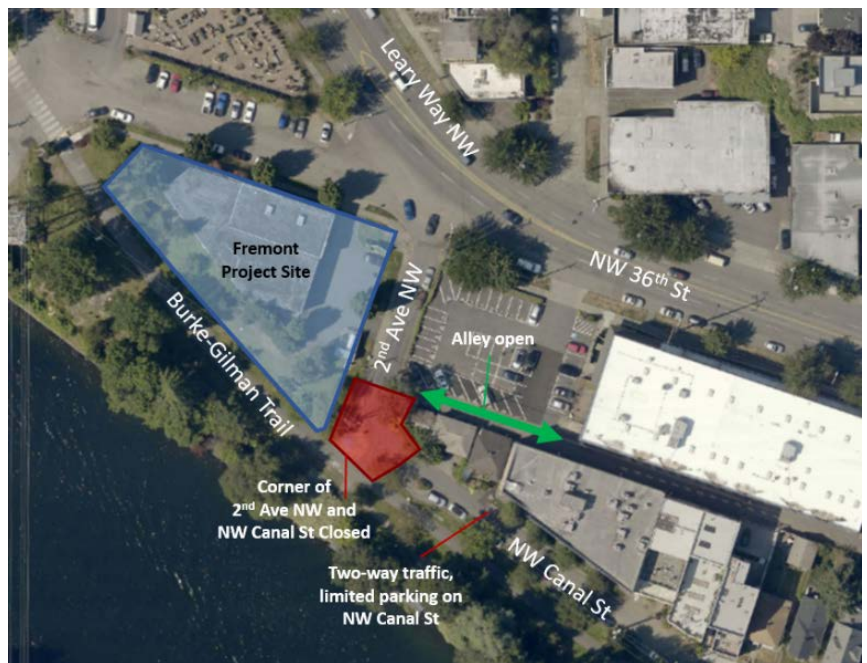
This work is weather dependent and could be rescheduled. We will send additional notification if the schedule changes.

#### What to expect

- Work on the Fremont site from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Lighting onsite to maintain safe working conditions.
- Crews onsite after hours, with typical construction noise.
- No heavy equipment will be used.
