Westbound traffic on Northeast Juanita Drive detoured in front of Juanita Bay Pump Station work site during week of July 7, 2008

Puget Sound Energy crews will connect the new Juanita Bay Pump Station to the power grid during the week of July 7, 2008. Westbound traffic on Northeast Juanita Drive will be routed into the center turn lane in front of the pump station from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. weekdays while this work occurs.

Puget Sound Energy does not expect the work to affect electric service outside the work site.
