Construction underway!

To ensure safe and reliable operations and provide wastewater capacity for the future, the King County Wastewater Treatment Division is replacing the Juanita Bay Pump Station in Kirkland.

What should you expect in October?

King County's contractor will:

- Continue to bring equipment and materials to the pump station site and construction staging area in Juanita Beach Park
- Drill several wells to monitor ground water levels
- Drill test holes for the pump station foundation
- Drill and install sound walls on two sides of the pump station site, close to condos and apartments
- Install underground utilities (water and storm sewer pipes) under 93rd Avenue N.E.

Lane closure on 93rd Avenue NE in October

One lane of 93rd Avenue NE near the pump station site will be closed for several weeks while new utilities are installed. Traffic signs and flaggers will direct cars, bikes and pedestrians safely through the work area. Access to residences and Juanita Beach Park will be maintained at all times.


Periodic traffic revisions planned on NE Juanita Drive

As construction work proceeds, temporary traffic revisions on NE Juanita Drive will be required. These revisions will include:

- Closing a single lane as needed.
- Moving the pedestrian crosswalk to the west side of 93rd Avenue NE.
- Periodically closing the bike lane near the construction area, if needed.

Trucks will be crossing NE Juanita Drive from the construction staging area in Juanita Beach Park to the pump station site. Traffic signs and flaggers will direct cars, bikes and pedestrians safely through the work area. Access to residences and Juanita Beach Park will be maintained at all times.
