Demolition of Parks building planned in September 2004

King County protects public health and the environment by conveying and treating the region's wastewater. The county's Juanita Bay Pump Station, at 9290 Juanita Drive N.E., must be upgraded to meet wastewater pumping capacity and reliability needs for the next 50 years.

The current pump station site is too small for a new pump station, so the King County Wastewater Treatment Division has acquired nearby property on 93rd Avenue N.E. That property now contains a King County Parks maintenance building. During the month of September, the Parks building will be demolished to allow construction of the new pump station.

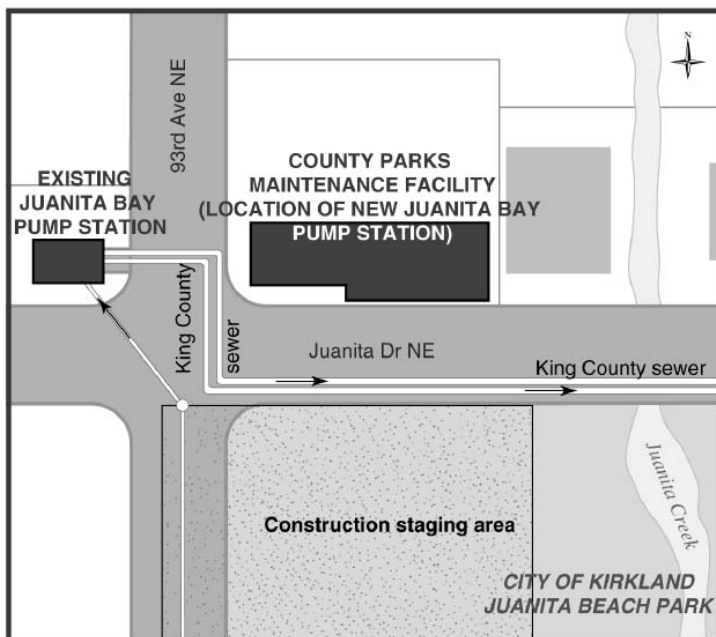
What can you expect during demolition?

- Demolition will take about a month.
- Construction will occur only on weekdays between 7:00 am and 8:00 pm. Longer workdays will ensure that demolition can be completed as quickly as possible.
- Appropriate measures will be taken to protect neighbors, children, pets, bicyclists, and motorists on nearby streets and sidewalks.
- Erosion control measures will be used to minimize dust during and after demolition.

What will happen next?

Following demolition of the Parks building, minor electrical work on the project site and in Juanita Beach Park (the construction staging area) will be completed. Construction of the new pump station is expected to begin in Spring 2005.
