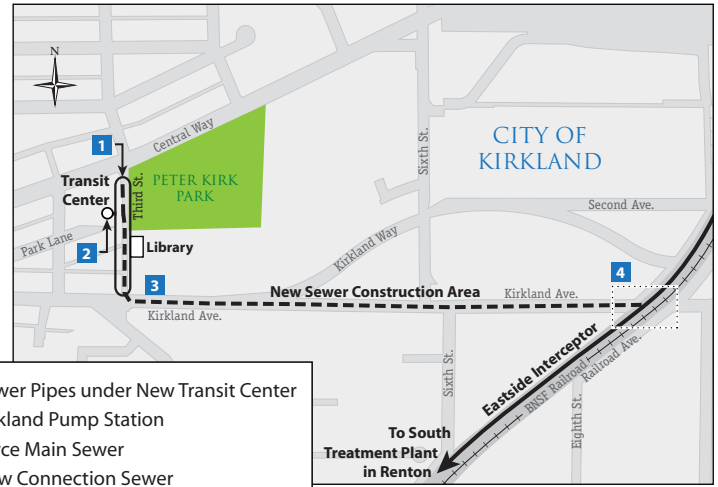

In early September, the King County Wastewater Treatment Division will begin work to upgrade the Kirkland Pump Station and Force Main to replace aging pump station equipment and to increase the capacity of the pump station. The pump station is located at the corner of Third Street and Park Lane in downtown Kirkland. Force main work will be carried out on Kirkland Avenue from 3rd Street to Railroad Avenue, where new pipelines will be connected to King County's existing conveyance system. Work on pipelines in Third Street is already completed in partnership with Sound Transit's Kirkland Transit Center Project.
