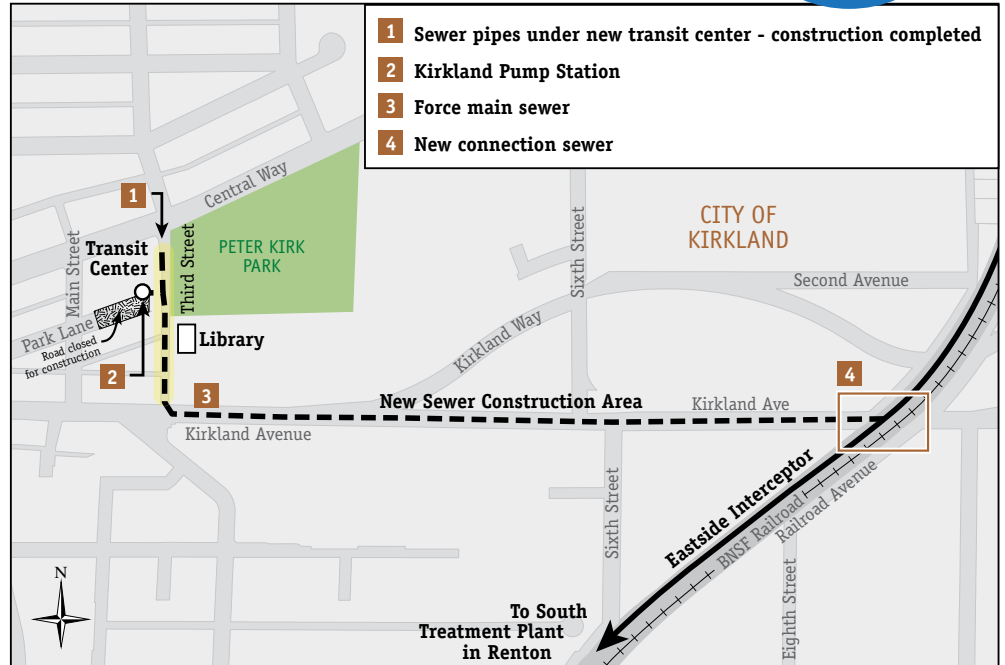


Kirkland Pump Station and Sewer Upgrade
