

King County's KIRKLAND PUMP STATION and SEWER UPGRADE PROJECT

March 4, 2013

Expect Periodic Minor Construction Impacts Sewer work near Railroad Avenue throughout March, 2013

Starting this week, a King County utility contractor will be completing minor construction activities near Railroad Avenue and Kirkland Avenue.

Planned work includes removing an existing gravel pile, replacing a manhole cover, and lowering a culvert. In order to complete this work, the contractor may shut down the pedestrian pathway for a portion of one day and reduce traffic lanes on Railroad Avenue (a flagger will be provided to assist drivers and pedestrians through the area). Crews plan to be working in this location periodically throughout the month of March.



What to expect:

- Short closures of the path along the railroad crossing near Kirkland Avenue.
- Temporary reduction of traffic lanes on Railroad Avenue.
- Work hours Monday through Thursday, from 7 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.
- Noise and other activity typical of a construction site: work crews, dust, trucks, construction materials, and heavy machinery.
