Maintenance work scheduled for Saturday, January 17

King County contractors will be working at the Murray CSO Control Project site this Saturday, January 17. Saturday work will begin at 9 a.m. and finish by 6 p.m. A small crew will be inside the excavation pit to maintain the secant piles. Nearly all work will be completed with hand tools. Neighbors can expect to see activity at the project site and occasional noise from equipment moving around the site.
