Project update November 16, 2016

Underground storage tank now working! Restoration of nearby streets and sidewalks continues

King County's million-gallon underground storage tank is now working after passing all system tests. As early as next week, County operators will work inside the facility to monitor flows at the Murray Pump Station and operate the underground storage tank as needed.

Roadway restoration is complete on Beach Dr. S.W. The contractor is now restoring sidewalks near the site. Crews are also working in the access road south of Lowman Beach Park to upgrade a small sewer line. This work is expected to be complete by mid-December.



Street and sidewalk restoration is underway.

Schedule update

Landscaping and project art will finish up in early 2017, depending on weather (see schedule below). A fence will

remain around the site until all landscaping is complete. The public staircase on site will not be accessible until all project work is complete. Access to Lowman Beach Park will be maintained as it has been throughout construction.
