

NORTH BEACH CSO CONTROL PROJECT

Paving work in North Beach the week of March 10, 2014

As King County prepares to construct the North Beach Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Control Project, crews will pave the corner of NW 100th Street and NW Neptune Place to accommodate a reroute of King County Metro buses necessary during construction. After construction is complete (expected in late 2015) the area will be restored to current conditions.

Paving is scheduled to occur the week of March 10, 2014, and will take approximately two days, weather permitting. King County's contractor will work at the location in blue on the map below. There will be some traffic pattern changes as a result of this work, which is expected to be complete by **Friday, March 14**.

What Neighbors Can Expect

- Work hours from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.
- Flaggers, signs, orange barriers, and cones to help direct traffic around the paving work.
- Some noise and vibration close to the work area from the equipment.
- Restoration of the affected areas according to City of Seattle standards.
- Installation of covered signage in preparation for the road closure.

What's next for the North Beach CSO Control project?

King County is installing a new combined sewer overflow (CSO) control facility to store excess wastewater and stormwater flows during large storms, reducing untreated discharges from the North Beach Pump Station. Neighbors can expect the following activities in the coming months:

- **Ongoing:** King County contractor Stellar J Corporation has installed a trailer on the North Beach Pump Station site and will continue preparing the site for construction throughout March.
- **Early April:** Intersection closure at NW Neptune Place, NW 100th Street, NW Blue Ridge Drive, and Triton Drive NW. Intersection will remain closed for up to one year.
