Road paving next week, intersection opening Monday, August 31

Did you notice the new curbs being installed this week on the project site? The contractor is getting ready for paving the intersection beginning Monday, August 24 (weather dependent). Paving will be complete on Wednesday, August 26. New traffic signage and striping will also be installed. **The intersection of Blue Ridge Drive NW and NW Triton Drive will reopen on Monday, August 31.** The site will be very busy during paving; read more about what to expect below.

Thank you for your patience during the water outage Tuesday. Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) connected the final waterline that was moved last year to make room for the new underground storage tank. With this piece of work complete, the intersection can be paved and reopened. This was the final utility outage required for the project. If you have questions or concerns about the water service disruption, or specific requests for notifications before planned outages, please contact SPU at (206-684-3000). SPU works directly with their affected customers when there is a planned disruption of services.

Crews will be working this Saturday, August 22, to finish final grading in preparation for paving on Monday.

What to expect during paving (August 24 – 26)

- Many asphalt trucks on and around the project site. The contractor will install a 13-inch deep layer of new asphalt.
- Odors from laying the asphalt. These odors will subside after paving is complete on August 26.
- Much more general activity on site than usual.
- Installation of stop signs and striping the roadway.

What to expect this week, before paving

- Increased noise and vibrations (within permitted limits) from excavators working to grade and prepare for paving next week.
- Concrete trucks on site for curb installation.
- Continued work on the North Beach Pump Station site and mechanical/electrical building.
