



Project Update – December 9, 2015

King County’s North Beach Wet Weather Storage Facility is now in operation, reaching a major project milestone! As construction comes to a close, we wanted to highlight several activities.

Removal of the construction contractor’s trailer

With the new facility online, we are nearing the end of the North Beach Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Control Project. Next week the contractor will be removing the work trailer from the site. This will require the use of a truck crane. The crane will lift the trailer onto a truck parked in the intersection of Triton Drive N.W. and N.W. Neptune Place. Flaggers will be present to direct vehicle and pedestrian traffic around these activities.

Finish work to continue in early 2016

While the bulk of construction work will be completed in mid-December, the contractor will be completing some work on the pump station site through early 2016. This includes work on the new building and final landscaping. Crews will access the pump station site intermittently on weekdays between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. to complete this work.

King County operation crews will start accessing the site

As in the past, County crews will visit the site on a scheduled basis to monitor pump station operations and conduct routine maintenance work. This will usually involve a small crew with one or two vehicles on site. This routine maintenance work will not affect traffic or access around the pump station. As the storage facility begins operations, you may see crews checking the new vaults.
