

Project Update

December 7, 2016

Drainage work near N.W. 100th and N.W. Neptune Place week of Dec. 12

King County's contractor will install drainage improvements at the corner of N.W. Neptune Place and N.W. 100th Street, and at the corner of N.W. Neptune Place and N.W. Blue Ridge Drive.

Crews will begin work on **Monday, December 12**, and expect to finish Friday, Dec. 16.

Crews will remove temporary erosion control, and install river rock and a low asphalt curb to channel stormwater into catch basins. The City of Seattle approved and permitted the work plans.

The project will close half a traffic lane around the work areas. Cones will outline the reduced lane. Flaggers will direct traffic around the work.

What to expect:

- Crews working weekdays from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Some noise and vibration associated with construction work
- Flaggers onsite to direct traffic around the work area
- No parking in the work areas
