



Eastside Interceptor (Section 13) Lining Project

Completed – October 2016

The County issued final acceptance for this project on October 11, 2016.

Project description


In early 2016, work began a section of the Eastside Interceptor (ESI) in Bellevue. The ESI sewer line that carries wastewater from homes and businesses in Bellevue, Kirkland, Redmond, Issaquah, and the Sammamish Plateau to the [South Treatment Plant in Renton](#). Work included:

- Installing pipe lining along approximately 1,360 feet of the 72-inch diameter pipe
- Excavation at three locations to allow access to the pipeline
- Installing erosion control, supports, dewatering wells and monitoring equipment
- Restoring areas disturbed by construction

This work is part of a program to restore corroded sewer lines throughout the regional wastewater system. Pipe lining is a cost-effective way of maintaining the sewer lines. It saves on materials and energy use, when compared to installing new sewer lines.
