

PACIFIC PUMP STATION REPLACEMENT PROJECT

December 2006

NIGHT WORK & EXTENDED HOURS DECEMBER 13-16, 2006

King County contractors will connect the new Pacific wastewater pump station to the existing force main underneath Tacoma Boulevard North on Wednesday, December 13.

Work will begin at 8 P.M. and should be completed by early Thursday morning. Working at night minimizes the project's impact on traffic and the community's wastewater service.

Crews will also work from 7 A.M. – 7 P.M. at the existing pump station site from Thursday, December 14 – Saturday, December 16 to complete related pipe work.

These activities will <u>not</u> disrupt wastewater services. Flow received at the existing pump station during work hours will be pumped into storage trucks and returned to the system at manholes north of the work site on Tacoma Blvd N and Milwaukee Blvd S.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Increased exhaust fumes, noise and equipment at the existing pump station site on Tacoma Blvd N & 1st Ave NW
- Increased truck traffic along Tacoma Blvd N and Milwaukee Blvd S after 8 P.M. on December 13
- King County crews working in the road and blocking traffic lanes near:
 - -- Tacoma Blvd N & 1st Ave NW
 - -- Milwaukee Blvd S & Tacoma Blvd N
 - -- 3rd Ave & Tacoma Blvd N
