PACIFIC PUMP STATION REPLACEMENT PROJECT

July 2005

Construction of a new wastewater pump station is under way next to Custom Iron on Frontage Road North in Pacific. King County began the project about one year ago to replace an existing pump station on Tacoma Boulevard North.

To protect public health and the environment, King County is replacing the outdated pump station to protect public health and the environment. The old station does not meet modern building and safety codes, and its equipment is outdated.

The Pacific Pump Station serves homes and businesses in Pacific and Algona. About 350,000 gallons of wastewater is pumped through the station every day to King County's regional treatment plant in Renton.

Construction of the new pump station should take about three years. King County is still expecting completion of all construction in the summer of 2006.

New Pipeline Construction


A new pipeline is also needed to connect the sewer system to the new pump station. The map at right shows the path of the pipeline. It will cross the Interurban Trail and between the apartment buildings on Tacoma Boulevard.

Construction of the new pipeline will begin in July and take about three months. In addition there will be more work on Tacoma Avenue in the fall and at the end of the project in 2006.

The construction will block some parking for the apartment buildings at 102 Tacoma Boulevard.

King County and the contractor will try to minimize disruption during construction. But the work will cause some noise and construction traffic.

Crews will work Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. to complete the project on time. If necessary, workdays and hours may change.
