

VEYANCE PROJECT



Update Jan. 12, 2018

Over the last few weeks, King County's contractor for the Magnolia Conveyance Project finished excavating and installing shoring boxes at their site in Smith Cove Park. Over the next several months, crews will be working onsite in Smith Cove Park and on 32nd Avenue West to prepare to connect another pipe to the Magnolia Wet Weather Facility.

Crews may work on Saturdays during approved construction hours.

Construction activities in Smith Cove Park

Crews will continue construction activities in Smith Cove Park to clean the existing pipe and prepare for pipe installation. People visiting the park can expect the following:

- Weekday work hours typically from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Saturday work hours typically from 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Construction equipment located onsite and near the entrance of the existing pipe in the southwest corner of the park.
- Increased noise and vibration in the work area
- Traffic control personnel and signs to direct traffic and pedestrians around the work zone, as necessary
- The northern athletic fields remain open for use

Construction activities on 32nd Ave. W.

Starting the week of January 15, crews will prepare a laydown area for materials and equipment near the diversion structure on 32nd Avenue West. They will also begin installing erosion control and monitoring equipment. Residents on 32nd Avenue West can expect the following:

- Weekday work hours typically from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Saturday work hours typically from 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Construction equipment located onsite including excavators, pumps and trucks
- Orange construction fencing around the construction area
- Increased noise from construction equipment
- Traffic control personnel and signs to direct traffic and pedestrians around the work zone, as necessary

King County will work with the community every step of the way by offering information through the following forums:

- Briefings and site visits: We will be working with community groups and neighbors to schedule briefings and site visits. If you would like us to attend your community group meeting or a neighborhood meeting, please feel free to email us.
- Email updates: We will continue to keep you informed through these email updates about what you can expect during construction.

- Online open house: Over the next several months, we will update the <u>online open house</u> with new construction information, as it becomes available. Please share the online open house information with your neighbors who may not be on our email list.
