

Update: Preparation for pipe bursting continues, and short delays on 32nd Avenue West

King County's contractor continues preparations to install the pipe in late March/early April. Crews are fusing pipe sections in the closed area of 32nd Avenue West. Soil freezing equipment is being removed at Smith Cove, and replaced with a drill rig (see back).

People driving on 32nd Avenue West will have 5-10 minute delays while equipment is moved on the street. These delays will help protect worker safety while equipment is being moved through the narrowed area of 32nd Avenue West.

32nd Avenue West:

Work Hours: Weekdays from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.; Saturday construction from 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.*

Traffic:

- 32nd Ave. W. is closed between Clise PI. W. and 33rd Ave. W.
- 32nd Ave. W. is narrowed to one lane near the diversion structure, just south of the West Howe Street bridge.

*The schedule and duration for construction is tentative and subject to change as work progresses. Crews may work until 10 p.m. to maintain progress as needed.

Smith Cove Park:

People visiting the Smith Cove Park will see increasing amounts of equipment on the site as the contractor prepares to pull another pipe from 32nd Avenue West to Smith Cove.




We have new information posted on our updated online open house.
