## **Update: Preparation for pipe bursting continues, and short delays on 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West**

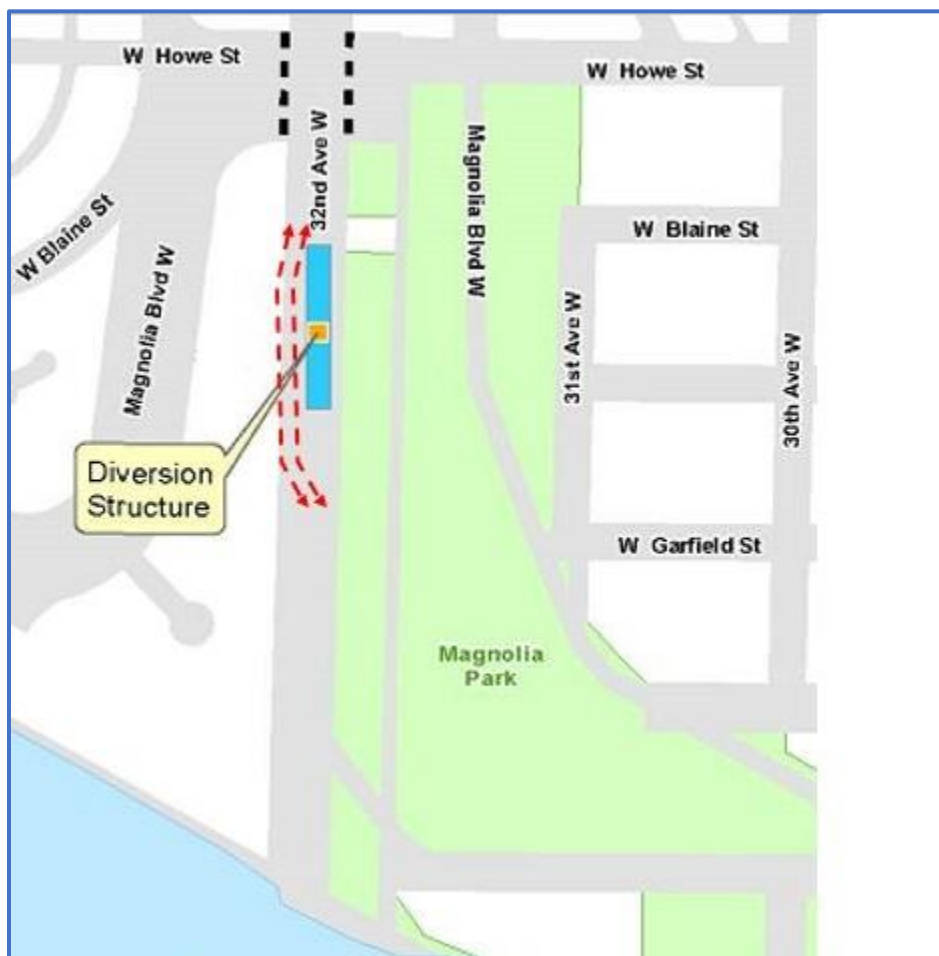
King County's contractor continues preparations to install the pipe in late March/early April. Crews are fusing pipe sections in the closed area of 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West. Soil freezing equipment is being removed at Smith Cove, and replaced with a drill rig (see back).

People driving on 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West will have 5-10 minute delays while equipment is moved on the street. These delays will help protect worker safety while equipment is being moved through the narrowed area of 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West.

### **32nd Avenue West:**

**Work Hours:** Weekdays from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.; Saturday construction from 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.\*

#### **Traffic:**

- 32nd Ave. W. is closed between Clise Pl. W. and 33rd Ave. W.
- 32nd Ave. W. is narrowed to one lane near the diversion structure, just south of the West Howe Street bridge.

*\*The schedule and duration for construction is tentative and subject to change as work progresses. Crews may work until 10 p.m. to maintain progress as needed.*

### **Smith Cove Park:**

People visiting the Smith Cove Park will see increasing amounts of equipment on the site as the contractor prepares to pull another pipe from 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West to Smith Cove.
