## **Update: Pipe installation activities begin Wednesday, April 25**

King County's contractor will begin the final process to install a new pipe for the Magnolia Wet Weather Facility. The first step will be to fuse pipe sections on 32nd and Clise Place W, beginning Wednesday morning. King County's Community Services team has been working with residents most affected in the work area as pipe installation approaches. We will be on site or available throughout pipe installation.

### **Important notes for neighbors**

Crews will begin to fuse and stage longer sections of the pipe Wednesday morning, April 25 at 10 a.m. At that time, the east side of 32nd Avenue West will be blocked and delays up to 2 hours will occur. Pedestrians can walk by the area. Residents will be able to drive through most of the day.

Once longer sections of pipe are fused, crews will begin installing and fusing the full pipeline as early as Thursday, April 26. At that time, overnight work will begin. Pipe installation must continue around the clock and may take up to four days to complete.

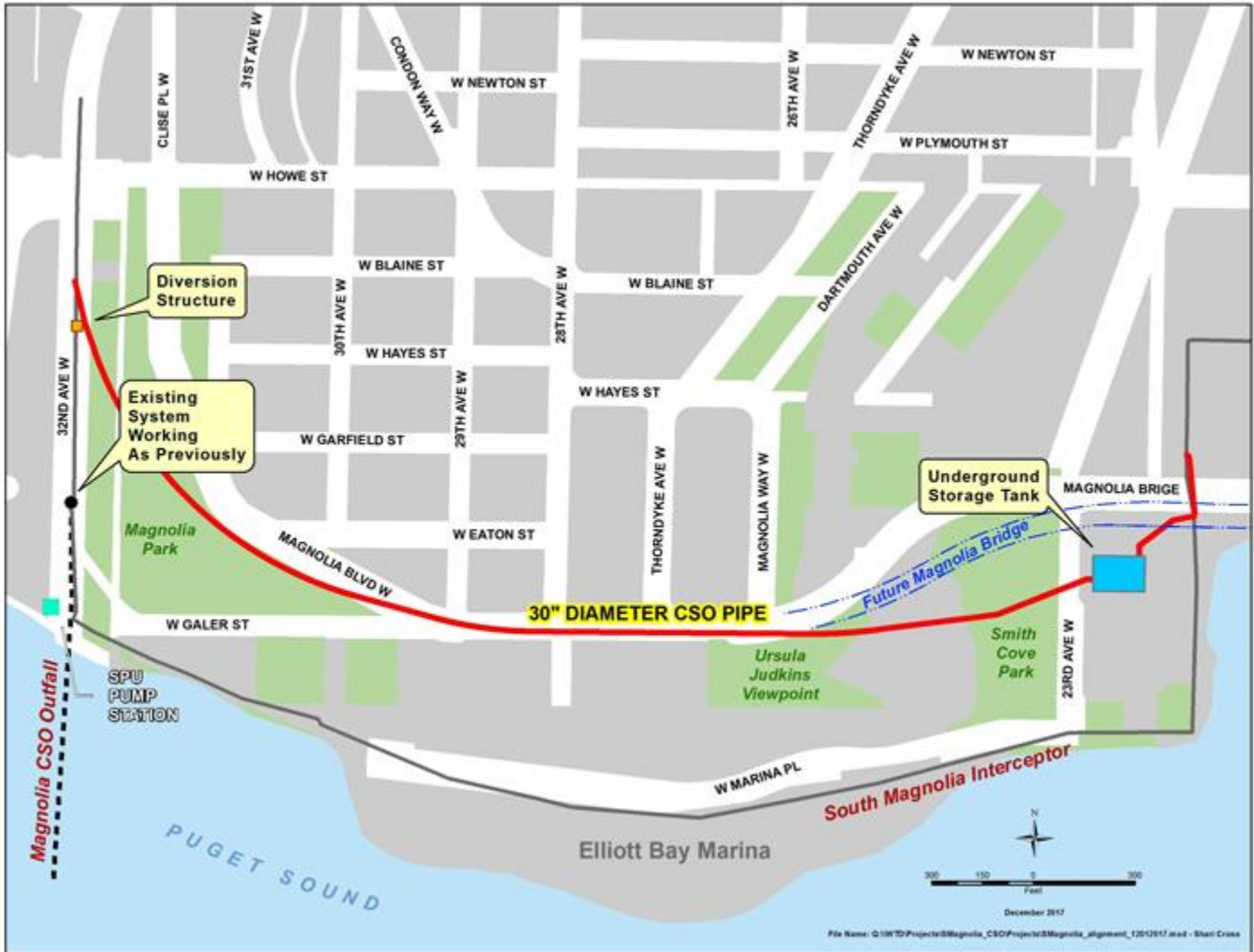

### **If you do not live in the project area**

Please be considerate of the project neighbors who are affected by this work.

- You can safely view the project work from the Howe Street Bridge
- Avoid 32nd Avenue West during pipe installation work. One lane of the road will be occupied by project equipment and materials. The remaining lane must stay open for resident and emergency access

- There will be no parking available for non-residents during the pipe installation work. Parking is also limited in surrounding areas, including 33rd Avenue West and Wolfe Street. Closure of the parking lane on Clise Place West will mean some residents must park in the neighborhood away from their homes
