

## Survey work on West Galer Street

## Thursday, May 31

After completing pipeline installation, King County's contractor is continuing the restoration phase of the pipeline remediation project. On Thursday, May 31, crews will work along West Galer to evaluate the subsurface area along the pipeline alignment. Ground-penetrating radar will be used this week. Later, the County's geotechnical contractor will evaluate using the tomography method residents experienced previously.


A small crew will be on hand with limited equipment, for 1-2 work days. We will notify you if additional work is needed this week. You can expect survey crews and assessment to continue for the next few weeks as part of the restoration activities on West Galer Street.

Monitoring and surveying activities will continue throughout the completion of the restoration work.

## What you can expect:

- Work will extend for 1-2 work days.
- Traffic control will be set up about 6:00 a.m. and work will begin at 7:00 a.m.
- Two-way traffic will be maintained, but lanes will be shifted and traffic will be directed around the work site.
- Bicycles will travel with vehicle traffic.
- Please drive slowly and obey signs and flaggers!
