Restoration work to resume on West Galer Street week of September 17

VEYANCE PROJECT

King County's contractor for the Magnolia pipe project is resuming restoration work throughout the project area. Neighbors may have noticed reduced work activity during the operators' strike, which you probably saw in the local news. Now that there is resolution on the regional labor issue, restoration activity on West Galer Street will resume.

Beginning the week of September 17, King County's geotechnical consultant will use recently installed wells to survey conditions deep below the surface. This work will require traffic control around the work area. Traffic control may include a uniformed officer to make sure people are traveling safely through the area.

We will update project neighbors on the schedule as crews make progress. We appreciate your patience as the County's contractor makes progress to complete this project.

What you can expect:

- Work hours from 7 a.m. until 5 p.m.
 Work may extend later as needed.
- Two-way traffic will be maintained, but lanes will be shifted, and traffic will be directed around the work site.
- Bicycles will travel with vehicle traffic.
