Station construction is expected to begin in Spring 2018!

Last year, Flatiron West Inc. was awarded the treatment station construction by King County. Site preparation and demolition activities were completed in 2017. Starting this spring, crews will be onsite to begin construction. Community members near the site may see the following activities:

- Crews staging equipment and trailers
- Trucks going in and out of site
- New project banners hung on the site fence
- Excavating soil onsite



The project hotline will return to being staffed 24/7 once construction begins.

Once built, the treatment station will collect and clean up to 70 million gallons of sewage and storm water per day. This will greatly reduce the amount of untreated water that would otherwise spill into the Duwamish River.
