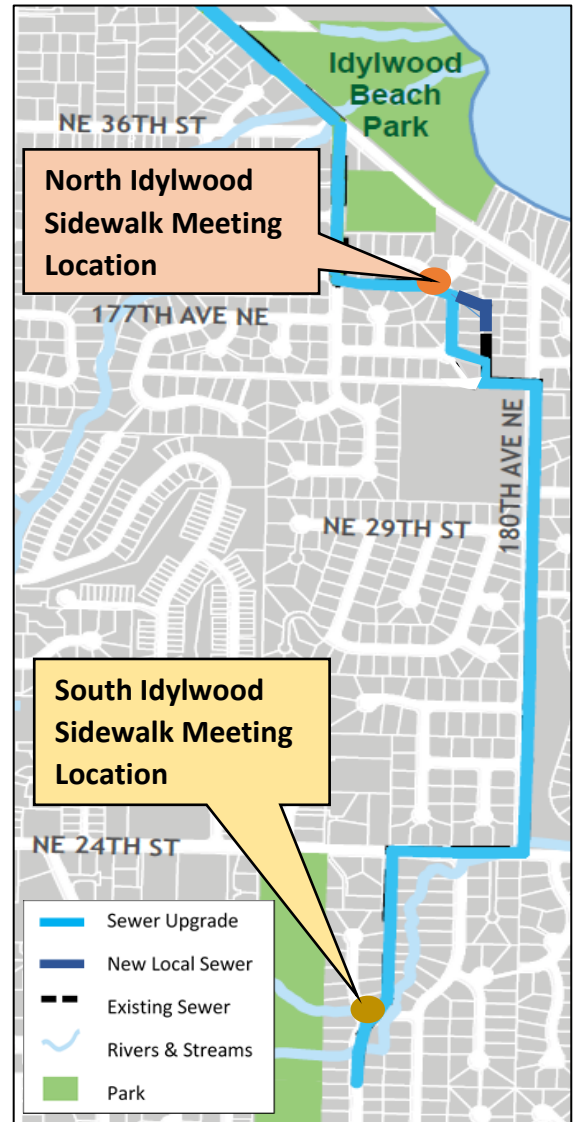
South Idylwood Sidewalk Meeting
